Entry Order on Election Recount Certification

On Friday, November 22, 2024, the Windsor County Clerk conducted a recount regarding the 2024 general election for seat Windsor-3 in the Vermont House of Representatives. On Monday, November 25, 2024, the Clerk certified the results of the recount to this court. The two candidates with the highest vote totals in the election will represent the District in the Vermont House of Representatives.

The County Clerk's certification establishes the following vote totals:

Kristi Morris	-	2,062
Alice Emmons	-	2,047
Keith Stern	-	2,025
Judith Stern	-	1,891

Eight ballots were marked as defective. No disputed ballots were submitted to the Court for review.

Pursuant to 17 V.S.A. § 2602j(c), the candidates are entitled to an opportunity to present evidence to the court regarding the conduct of the recount. Any candidate may file a written request for a hearing to present evidence related to the recount on or before December 6, 2024. Should a request be filed, the court will issue a decision on the recount following notice of a hearing and an opportunity to be heard. If no candidate timely seeks such a hearing, the court will enter a final order confirming that candidates Kristi Morris and Alice Emmons are the winners of the 2024 general election for Vermont House of Representatives District Windsor-3.
